## Math <br> 6 Steps for Solving Word Problems

1. Convert the words into an equation.
2. Go back to the beginning.
3. Look for Signal Words that mean certain mathematical operations.
4. Perform the required operations.
5. Make sure you are answering the question that is being asked of you.
6. Mentally or on paper check your answer to make sure it is correct and makes sense.
